Annotated Bibliography Assignment

Formulate a question or issue involving the study of psychological aspects of some cultural phenomenon or the study of cultural aspects of some psychological phenomenon. Use PsycINFO, and other appropriate academic databases as appropriate, to select a set of articles related to your question/issue. Prepare an annotated bibliography of five to eight articles from among those you select; do not include any articles assigned in the course. The bibliography should be presented in APA style and have the following elements:

A cover page with a brief title, your name, and your student number;

A 250– to 500-word introduction to your bibliography in which you

describe the question/issue of interest to you,

summarize briefly the process by which you located and selected the articles included in your bibliography,

summarize the major insights gained from your library research,

provide your overall assessment of the fit between the articles in your bibliography and the assigned articles in the course.

A list of the full references in APA format for your 5–8 articles

For each article, an annotation of one or two paragraphs in which you

describe how the article relates to your question/issue, how it contributes to your understanding of the question/issue,

comment on how the article relates to any material we have studied in the assigned course readings.

In other courses you may have had annotated bibliography assignments in which the goal was to summarize each of several articles located in your library research. For our assignment, such summarization is *not* the goal. Rather you are seeking to show an ability to draw relationships between the articles located and

1. a cultural psychology question/issue, and

2. the material (ideas, concepts, questions, methodology, approaches, etc.) considered in our course.
